

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR ARTICLE PREPARATION

### Title

### Subtitle

### Author(s) list

- First name Last name
  - presenting author in bold
  - authors separated by ','

### Coordinates

- affiliation (faculty, institute or company), department, address - e-mail

### Introduction

- problem in science
- narrower problem within
- yet narrower problem relating to the topic of the paper
- summary (approach / results)

### Methods Summary

- What was done?
  - scientific question
  - general methods
  - answers sought
- How was it done/processed?

### Results

- What was found? The results should be objective observations.
- What do the results mean and how do they relate to previous findings
  - limitations of the study
  - how to interpret / fix

### Conclusion

- A brief summary of the implications of the results

### References

- a list of previously published papers, and databases relating to the paper
- at the end of the text, by the order of appearance in the paper (**Vancouver style**).

## TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please write in the form of a review paper, concisely and clearly.

- Expected length of abstract is 1 page
- Expected length of the full paper is 6 pages (optimal 2000 words)
- Mark the page number at the bottom
- Paper title: bold, font Times New Roman 14
- Subtitle: bold, font Times New Roman 12

- Text: font Times New Roman 12
- 1.5 line spacing
- Do not indent paragraphs
- Number the figures / tables in the text and state their text-independent title, indicate the reference to the number in the text (Table 1, Figure 1, etc.)
  
- References: **Vancouver style** - they should appear at the end of the text of your essay/paper listed numerically in the order that they were cited in the text.
